all supplies can be purchased at Asel, Michael's or Hobby Lobby

*****The very important Basics:**

- 9"x12" pad of **Bristol** Smooth (or the larger size of 11"x14")
- disposable inking pens that are Waterproof in a variety of sizes such as: **Staedtler** Pigment Liners, **Micron** in .01, .03, .05, .07; **Faber-Castell** Pitt Artist pen in S, M, L; **Artist's Loft** is a Michael's brand and they are quite good as well.
- 1-2 **Prismacolor** (clear) Colorless Blender marker & 1 **Prismacolor** black marker

*****Common supplies that you probably already have that are super helpful:**

- HB pencil or harder (such as F, 2H, 4H, etc)
- white **Magic Rub** eraser in block or clickable such as a **Tuff Stuff**
- X-acto blade or good pair of scissors
- paper tape or draftsman's tape (artist tape)
- metal ruler (preferably cork backed)
- sketchbook or note pad to doodle and sketch on (I do give handouts to be written on as well)

*****Optional supplies depending on your preferences:**

- Field Sketch board or Drawing board
- Watercolor Paper or Marker Paper; tracing paper
- Derwent** Watercolor pencils, Graphtint pencils or Inktense
- India Ink or Drawing Ink
- Watercolor pan or Watercolor Pencils
- Golden** High Flow Acrylics or Acrylic Inks
- Paint brushes of various sizes & textures
- Colored Pencils- **Faber-Castell** Polychromos Pencils or **Prismacolor** Verithin and/or Premier colored pencils: **Faber-Castell** or **Prismacolor** colored markers

Or any combination of the above! If you have materials that you would like demonstrated and shown how to use – bring them in. It's all about finding the right thing for you! Every week we will go through a different technique and material so that you can sample different approaches and techniques to drawing.
